## Daniel, Bish and Patch hit centuries

Three centuries, one of them a match winner, were the highlights of the weekend when N&CCC showed a pleasing capacity to fight against all odds.

Adam Patching, reprising his “almost” double century against Torquay a few years back, produced the match-winner.

Patchie scored a mighty 102, dominating an opening stand of 77 with Tim Sanderson (5), as the Fourth XI beat East Belmont on Shaw Oval.

We know the way Patch bats. When it works to the full, he is in a class of his own: principal, teacher and top student.

In the Third XI’s heart-aching loss, Campbell Bishop played an innings of amazing wristy fluency, coming to the crease after the loss of a couple of early wickets, to be quickly followed by a couple more. Then in cahoots with Frank Tuskes (a blazing 77), he restored the game to N&CCC’s favour, only to see the advantage evaporate and the match lost by a narrow margin. This, despite some fighting last wicket heroics from Scott Sanderson and Jack Johnson.

Jack’s dismissal, a tight run out, might easily have gone to the third umpire.

The third century proved, or re-proved in the eyes of the knowing, that D.W. Lawrence of Chingford, Essex and Newtown can bat.

One of the greybeards that assemble for libation on Saturday nights at Queens Park noted wryly the other night that none of the “Poms” who have graced our club in recent years had scored a century.

Well that was put to right in a style that was as compelling as any century made by a Two Blue player in recent years.

This bloke will still be 17 when he leaves us. In this innings there was a mix of youthful talent, maturing precision and even a playful haughtiness as he sent the

grown men of one of the GCA’s best attacks to all parts of Winter Oval.

As he lamented afterwards, if only he’d last another five overs. Ah, cricket and its “if onlys” – a book of a million chapters.

There should also be special mention of Rhys Bennett’s innings in support of an opening stand of 115 and the noble attempts of Tim Hosking, Nic Locandro and Marc Carson to steal an unlikely win.

Those words again. If only a few more catches had been held and 293 would have been a lot less.

The Second XI had no century maker, the top-scorer Scott Dimovski with an almost half-century.

Mitch Davis produced a fine spell, taking three wickets, and Chris Byrne continues to grow as an all-rounder.

You don’t need to be a cricketing guru with a thousand years of experience to know it would have been better to have won a few more games, particularly those which contained N&CCC century-makers. If only again.

But as the coach, the First XI captain, the chairman of selectors and the rest of the cricket department patiently work their way to the inevitable better and better times, the fighting spirit against a highly-rated opponent was there to be seen.

And in such capable hands, that can be distilled into something special as the summer rolls on.
