Two Blues show plenty of fighting spirit

Young sides can't afford to drop their guards for a moment, especially when they're playing against a highly experienced and talented opponent.

South Barwon is such a side, and by the end of day one at Queens Park the Swans had pocketed the six points and would have turned up on day two thinking about four more with a great deal of confidence.

What happened next will be talked about for a long time around our club.

Daniel Lawrence's 191 was one of the most compelling of knocks ever seen at our holy ground.

No less an authority than David Shaw says so.

"That's the best innings I've seen at this ground," declared The Patron.

And there was a mighty chorus of support for that summation among the grey beards.

He began the day on 39 not out, he reached his half-century with that minimum of effort which is quickly becoming his trade mark – feet wide apart, a rapid, flick of the wrist followed only occasionally by the need to run.



In the blink of an eye, he was in the nineties. The boundary to take him to three figures was contemptuous of bowler and fielders. No need to run.

So too, late in his innings when just about every Swan but the keeper and the bowler was on the fence, was another boundary – absolutely bisected the two blokes patrolling out near the netball courts. Only in the pursuit of quick runs to create the most unlikely of declarations did he look vulnerable.

By stumps, N&CCC looked like it had found another good 'un, newbie leg-spinner Jake Allen. He's just 18, and already seems to have quite a few of the necessary tricks needed if a wristie is going to survive at this level.

So while there is much to be learned from day one, particularly about that need to have your guard up from the first ball, by the end of day two there was much about which to feel optimistic, very optimistic.

And you might think that some of those blokes who so far this season have declined the opportunity to play with a bloke of such obvious talent might be wondering about the wisdom of that choice. This was tell your grandchildren stuff.

It was a privilege to watch Daniel's innings from the balcony.

It would have been even more special to have been a part of it as a team mate. The beaming smiles as the players came up the stairs at break showed that. Jacko's eyes were dancing, he knew he had been part of something special. The coach was purring, too. When Daniel asked how his horse went at Flemington, Rocket said "well it would have wouldn't it, you've won everything else today".

Twads was going to put Pako Meats on the stock market, suggesting good quality protein obtained therein was the reason for Daniel's mighty innings and shareholders the world over would want to be part of it.

"He'll play for England," said the other English accent resident in the First XI.

Both N&CCC and Chingford, Daniel's London-based club, have produced two Test cricketers. In our case, we claim Redpath and Hassett. In theirs, Insole and Hobbs. I reckon both clubs would happily share the third.

- the 15th highest score by an N&CCC player.
- the 5th highest in the 1st XI equalling Vin Hassett's 191.
- His partnership with Marc Carson of 172 for the 6th wicket is a record partnership in the 1sts for that wicket, eclipsing Vic Profitt and Terry Baird's 138 set in 1929.
