A comprehensive win over Geelong West in the mid-week T20 competition was some consolation for a disappointing fortnight for the Two Blues.

Marc Carson and Mitch Davis were the major wicket-takers as the Westies made 7-145, a pretty decent score, on Queens Park.

The Newtown reply, apart from the early departure of Nic Locandro, was nothing short of stunning.

Daniel Lawrence led the way, and was closely followed by Scott Dimosvki, whose stroke play was at times breath-taking, and other times breathless.

English import Daniel Lawrence ‘as good as Finch and Buchanan’

MARC Carson has seen his fair share of batting displays in his time.

After a career at Premier level, he knows a good knock when he sees one, and that's just what he saw from Newtown & Chilwell's English import Daniel Lawrence last week.

"It's as good as I've seen since a Buchanan or a Finch. He manipulated the field and just hit it wherever he wanted to hit it," Carson said.

The 17-year-old has wasted little time making his mark on the new GCA1 season, with his second-innings 191 last week against South Barwon following on from a 111 the previous round against East Belmont.

"The week before we didn't have the best week, we were bowled out for 82 and they got in and declared (3-86)," Lawrence said.

"I got out first ball in that first innings.

"The second innings I was 14 not out overnight and then just sort of went from there.

"The next morning I got myself in, got to 60-70, then got to 100 and then just started playing shots a little bit and it came off for me. It was good."

Lawrence continues the link between Newtown and Essex County Cricket Club's Academy, becoming the fifth player to join the club through the Insole/Gooch scholarship program.

"It's good practice over the winter. It's good to see a lot of Australia and I just thought it was a really good opportunity, too hard to turn down," he said.

The opening batsman played Second XI for Essex last year after signing a two-year professional contract at the end of 2013.

It's stiff competition to get into the First team, with internationals Jesse Ryder and Ravi Bopara in the side.

"I had a season in our Second XI back home and I did all right and I'm maybe looking to push on a bit next year and get a place in the ones," Lawrence said.

"I thought (I was close last season), I thought maybe if I'd made a couple more hundreds back home I probably would have got a shot but they're quite strong batting at Essex, people like Jesse Ryder and Bopara, it's hard to get in, but hopefully next season I can get a crack."

Newtown captain Carson said despite his age, Lawrence had brought more than just batting ability with him to Australia.

"He's brought a real enthusiasm to the club," Carson said.

"For a 17-year-old he bats beyond his years in experience, he knows the game quite well.

"With the amount of players we lost through the off-season, he's injected real energy and a vibrancy into the group.

"He's quite an aggressive batsman and a real shotmaker, he knows his game too, he's pretty impressive for a kid of his age."

Lawrence is also wearing the gloves while at Newtown, as he tries to add another string to his bow in preparation for the next season in England.

"I've been keeping, hopefully I can do it for my county when I get home," he said.

"There's a guy there now who's going to be there for a few years, but my bowling's not really good enough so I thought I'd have a go at keeping."

Lawrence's 191 last week eclipsed his previous personal best score of 165.
