Is this a world record?

History was made at Mt Duneed Oval when Neville Crane, who comfortably qualifies as an Australian Over 70s cricketer, opened the batting for Newtown and Chilwell's brand-spanking new GCA Eighths side with Patrick Silo, who comfortably qualifies for N&CCC's Under 15 Royce team.

We probably need to ask not only the great Barnso, or Kevin O'Dowd, but even Ross Dundas, keeper of all global cricket records, to see if this is a world record as well as a club and GCA one.

The age difference proved no barrier; the pair putting on 78 for the first wicket, before Patrick was out for a neatly compiled 23, while his ageless skipper went on to an unbeaten half-century.

What is does show is that the junior program with the most teams and players, as Newtown's is this summer (well done Jaffas, how's the back?), is also rippling with young talent.

And it has emerged that another of Paul and Neville's team has a claim to greatness.

Lindsay Fisher, a regular for Geelong's Over 60s for a few years, became a genuine Two-Blue on Saturday, his first game for the club.

Last summer, he had the pleasure of clean-bowling the former Australian Test captain, Graham Yallop.

According to those who have been told about it, and many times apparently, it swung both ways, then cut both ways, before cannoning into the woodwork of the man who scored 2756 runs for Australia at 41.13, including a highest score of 268.

Sadly for Neville's side making its debut in the GCA new tier competition, Lindsay was unable to rip through Highton quite as effectively, the side losing in the penultimate over.

With only the Fifths prevailing, and against the biggest substitution scandal since Fine Cotton, it was another weekend of reflection for the Two-Blues.

The First XI threatened on more than one occasion against the powerful South Barwon side, Shannas getting his first wicket for the club and Chris Pepper and Yves Roussety both playing solid if not ultimately match-winning innings.

It wasn't that long ago that that "one of our own" was saying that he and another of our juniors we haven't seen for a bit were going to be the next Russell Mitchell and Dev Royce of the club.

Thankfully the current Russell Mitchell and Dev Royce have made that happen by themselves.

Well done Specs for getting your side home against the odds. The weekend's results remind everyone of the need to work

harder.

Patrick Silo did.
