NEWTOWN & Chilwell has responded to a slow start to the season with a strong bowling performance to knock Leopold over for 149.

The Two Blues bowled with a constant threat, with the final wicket partnership of 36 between James Menzies and Harrison James being the highest for the Lions.

Harry Christie made the most of his return to the first XI, being best of the bowlers and picking up 4-59, with all wickets top-order batsmen.

In reply, Newtown was in danger at 2-24 with George Chisholm (21) and Grant Philpott (2) already dismissed, but Chris Pepper and Marc Carson steadied the ship to leave Newtown in a strong position after week one.

Leopold was just one of three grounds to see action, with Newtown and Chilwell falling 47 runs short of its target of 149.

Leopold captain-coach Luandre van Wyk felt the match was evenly poised, with his side needing seven wickets for victory before a storm ended play with 17 overs left to bowl.

“Even though they only needed another 50 we thought we were right in it,” van Wyk said.

“I think both captains would be a bit unhappy that the rain came in the end, but I think it was a fair result.”

The draw leaves both sides without a win after Round 3.
