Two Blues off to the perfect start

Dale works magic spell

A BRILLIANT spell of bowling by Dale Denny has given Newtown & Chilwell the perfect start to its season, leading the Two Blues to a 98-run win over Manifold Heights at Hurst Reserve.

After the Blues compiled 7-187, Denny took 6-8 from 9.4 overs, at one stage having an astonishing 5-0.

Denny's accurate medium-paced cutters rattled out the Sharks for just 89 in the 28th over, a poor start for the home side on their own turf.

Newtown & Chilwell coach Bryan Thomas said the former Geelong College and Collendina bowler quickly worked out the batsmen's weakness and was able to exploit them.

Earlier, the innings of 89 by Blues captain, Ben Neville, was just as crucial.

With his team sent in on a slow wicket with a slow outfield, Neville applied himself perfectly.

The outfield restricted him to three fours and three sixes but he was not dismissed until the total was 177.

Ben Knight had been effective with three wickets for the home side, but their batting then fell well short of what was required.

For the visitors, this win suggests they may make a far greater impact on the competition in 2011-12.

The Two Blues, brilliantly led by skipper Ben Neville began the new season in the perfect way by winning all four matches against a hapless Manifold Heights.

Batting first at Hirst Reserve the Two Blues totalled a competitive 7/187 from the allotted 50 overs with Benny Neville working a match winning 89 runs with 3 sixes and 3 fours. He was ably supported by Corey Mathieson (25) and debutante George Cameron (19) in vital partnerships.

The home side was going along steadily until Dale Denny emerged to clean up the innings with a remarkable 6 for 8 from his 10 overs with 7 maidens!

In other grades Eddie Ratcliffe (66) and Rhys Bennett (30) set the Seconds on the road to victory in a chase of 133.

Tom Beaumont's 5 for 10 was the key to the Thirds three wicket win over the Sharks. Veterans Frank Tuskes (29 not out) and Andy Garrigan (25) the best with the bat.

The Fourths rounded off round one's one dayers with a solid batting effort scoring 5/227 in reply to Manifold Heights 76.

All in all a great start let's continue the form and prepare well for up-the-hill neighbours St Josephs in round two

Life Members – three of a kind

At the Club's Annual General Meeting on June 14th three Club greats were honoured for their outstanding contribution to the Newtown and Chilwell Cricket Club over a period of 45 years.

Ian Hastie, Andrew Green and Stephen Wells have all made different but exceptional contributions and were warmly welcomed as the club's 36th, 37th and 38th Life Members.



306 games of cricket is a monumental effort and Ian Hastie has played all those getting the best out of his ability and contributing at all levels over the past 27 seasons. 6523 runs at 23.98 as an upper order bat and 255 wickets at 19.26 as a swing bowler testify to that.

Over 200 of Ian's matches have been on turf and he has been a pivotal player in the Second XI for over 15 years with two premierships in that grade. Ian has made a large contribution to the junior section of the club back to the early 90s. and on committee.



Despite the outward bravado Andrew Green is one not to push himself into the limelight. A consistent and reliable contributor Greenie has earned his status as a true Two Blue since joining the Club in 1993. A former Club President (7 years on committee) Greenie outstanding passion for the Club and his compassion has been highlighted in recent years in events such as the Jason Clark Foundation.

168 times he has passionately worn the Club cap scoring 3363 runs at 21.28 as an entertaining left had bat. A 5th XI premiership has been a reward for the solid on field contributor who has excelled in his off field deeds.



Born into a Club dynasty Stephen Wells grew up at Queen's Park representing his the state in both cricket and football having started his playing days as an 8 year old.

A six time Club premiership captain, coach and fearlessly aggressive competitor he also kicked off his outstanding career as a sporting administrator with a 10 year stint on the N&CCC committee.

Amassing 6664 runs for the club in all grades at an average of 31 in 225 matches, Wells scored nine centuries including a GCA record 237 in the 1st XI. 4627 in the 1sts averaging 33 saw him selected in the Centenary Team last season as a punishing opening bat.

Three very different club stalwarts who have added to our Club in their own ways and we congratulate and thank them for their contribution.
