Practice Wicket Update

The new Practice Wicket Complex is finally nearing completion.

Beak is adding the final touches to the shed and a TV and bar are also to be included – you may need a special handshake to get in!

A month ago Tony Devlin to organise putting down the artificial grass on most of the remaining cement areas of the hard wickets. Within a day or two the 'Phantom' helper Ian Simpson had marked the wicket area for the bowler's run ups and so this means that we are at last all but completed.

We now have a magnificent Practice Complex and Turf Maintenance Equipment Shed. It will ably service all club members both senior and junior for many years to come.

Thanks again to all members and their families that assisted at working bees, and in particular Scott Mullen, Graeme Taylor, David Murray, Tony Devlin, and Ian Simpson for their special contribution.

It is anticipated that each net will be 'named' as part of this ceremony - it has not been decided how at this stage.

The Complex will be officially opened just prior to or early next season. A plaque will be installed at the nets to recognise those responsible for their creation. It will also recognise those that have answered the call to donate funds to help cover the budgeted shortfall.

The cost of the artificial grass was not included in the original budget and it cost just under \$ 6,000, and it is our aim to cover this by members of the 'Newtown Cricket Family' donating towards it. It has been decided that every donation over \$ 100 will be recognised on this plaque.

We will keep the *Practice Wicket Campaign* open as long as we can prior to the Official Opening. As donations are received we will give updates on the progress until that time unless people prefer to do so anonymously.
