## Building a great club takes time, patience, and a lot of blood!

The difference between building a team, and building a club, is a subtle one often lost on the dimmer members of society. And no Scott Dimovski, we're not talking about you!

The difference can be found every time you drive past Kardinia Park, or read the front cover of the local paper which is promoting the wonderful Simon Townley's book From Good to Great.

We should never forget that before Geelong got to be Good enough to go for Greatness, it was stoney broke, the roof leaked as much as the bank accounts. The repair process has taken a decade of dedication, vision, guts, genius and a whole bunch of other things that have led to three premierships in five years, money in the bank, new stands in the offing and the things that steadfastly declare the club is great.

What GFC tells you is that there is no quick fix.

And painfully that applies – according to our president who lives and breathes these things – just as readily to the other GFC, the bloody global financial crisis.

But that's another story, we here to talk about building a club, and how it might best be done at the level at which N&CCC exists: essentially amateur, getting by on the good will of volunteers and a few underpaid semi-professionals.

Club sport, and especially football in these parts, is littered with stories of administrators who took the quick fix - buy a team, and hope the rest takes care of itself.

Invariably it doesn't, the team has some success, but built on the wrong values, ultimately falls over, leaving the dedicated but misguided volunteers with a lot of debts to pay off.

N&CCC is not making that mistake. Just as Geelong took Ablett,

Bartel, Ling, Johnson and so on as babies and nurtured them under the guidance of a coach who knew what he was about supported by an solid administration, so are we taking that path.

At times, like at North Geelong, it can frustrate the life out of you. And there's a potential for rumbles almost as loud as the thunder last Saturday.

But as Mick Malthouse once said, at the time showing off that he might once have read the Analects of Confucius while sitting on the dunny: The Ox is slow, but the earth is patient.

When you see how baby-faced some of our players are, we have to be like the Earth.

Because there is the core of a mighty first XI forming, all while off field good things are also happening.

Scott Mullen's greatest legacy to N&CCC won't be his first XI wickets or his Second XI premierships but the new training facilities. His blood is in there somewhere, everywhere, pints of it.

The shed going up next to is a credit to a new president who says build it and they will come. And those who should be among the first to come are companies who want to advertise their products to the citizenry of the Geelong.

The number of people besides us who use Queen's Park is amazing. Most of those people are in the much-favoured AB quintile that marketers love. It is premium advertising space. It will also be handy to keep some of GT's precious equipment dry.

So as we digest the last round, wins in the second and fourths, fifths and sevenths, losses in the other grades, it is good to remember what we are doing – building a great club, not just a great team.
