Rio brings Lynch off the bench

NEW Rio Tinto chief Sam Walsh has moved to further stamp his mark on the bruised miner, shaking up its executive committee.

AFL commissioner and former Transurban chief Chris Lynch will take over as the mining giant's chief financial officer, while the group's executive committee will be cut from 11 members to nine.

The Melbourne-based businessman is a non-executive director at Rio and will take up his post in April. He will replace Guy Elliott, a 30-year Rio veteran who announced his intention to stand down in June last year.

Mr Lynch, a former finance director at rival BHP Billiton, will move to London to take up the role.

Mr Walsh also scrapped the executive head of strategy position. The role was created by former chief executive Tom Albanese in the middle of last year and was to be filled by energy chief Doug Ritchie.

Both left Rio after it announced \$US14 billion (\$A13.6 billion) in fresh writedowns on its coal and aluminium assets.

The writedowns — which bring the total value of impairments at the company to about \$US34 billion over

the past five years — forced Rio to absorb a record \$US3 billion loss for 2012.

The executive committee position of business support and operations, filled by Bret Clayton, will also be dropped from the beginning of next month.

Duties will be transferred to the board and Mr Clayton will remain at the company.

Announcing the shake-up late yesterday, Mr Walsh said Mr Lynch was an “extremely high-calibre addition” to the executive team. He also praised Mr Elliott's contribution.

“We are fortunate to have appointed someone so well

qualified to take over from Guy and I am grateful to Guy for remaining on the board until the end of the year,” Mr Walsh said.

Mr Lynch, who left BHP in 2007 after being beaten to the top job by Marius Kloppers, said he would work on pursuing greater shareholder value.

“I am really looking forward to getting stuck into the challenge and ensuring we deliver on our promises to improve this great business,” he said.

He will be paid a base salary of \$1.2 million and is also eligible for bonuses worth up to \$3.9 million.

Rio Tinto's Australian-listed shares closed 1.6 per cent higher ahead of the announcement yesterday, at \$67.05.
