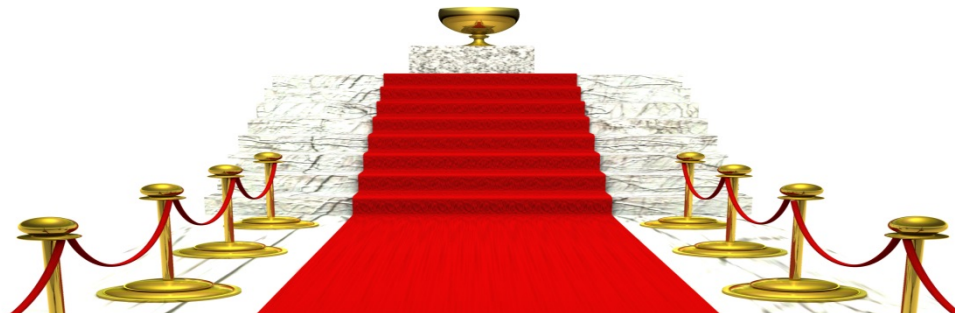

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE



The Newtown & Chilwell Cricket Club aims to provide an opportunity for everyone to participate in cricket, regardless of their gender, sexuality, age, level of ability or racial and cultural background, and enhance their health and wellbeing. The club will endeavour to provide a safe and supportive environment to ensure all members and their partners and families can fully participate in and feel part of the club.

These aims will be achieved by promoting the following:

- A sense of social and community values
- Valuing both participation and competition and having fun
- Respecting and valuing difference and diversity between people
- Respectful treatment of girls and women
- Good behaviour-on and off the field

- Training for members to undertake coaching, officiating and other leadership positions
