Meet.... Jon Carpenter

Jon Carpenter is the fourth player from the English county team, Essex, to spend a season at our club under the Gooch/Insole Program.



Jon bowls off-spin and bats in the middle order.

He made 17 on debut in the game against Grovedale, then followed that up on the second day with four catches, and two wickets.



A member of Graham Gooch Academy, Jon is highly regarded by Essex as a future first-class cricketer, and one with leadership possibilities.

He captained his own club, Rushton when he was 18, is already qualified as a Level II coach and already has considerable coaching experience with youngsters.

"It is an honour to be selected by Essex to come to Newtown," he said.

"I have played with all three of the previous players who have come here and they all speak highly of the club.

"In the short time I have been here I have been made to feel really welcome and I really enjoyed my first game.

"The club was buzzing after the win.

"I am really keen to see the club do well this year.

"I am also keen to help out with coaching, particularly with the juniors, but also with a group of off-spinners within the club."

Initially Jon was a promising tennis player, part of the Cliff Richard program in England.

"Then I discovered cricket and just fell in love with it," he said.

He played his first game of cricket as a seven-year-old, wicketkeeping for the Under 11s.

"I didn't stop a lot," he said.

"And the helmet was so heavy that when I left the field my head was hanging over to one side."

As he grew bigger and stronger, Jon developed his batting and was offered a place in the Essex academy.

There his off-spin bowling has also blossomed.

"I was a batsman really, but when I was offered a place at Essex in their academy, I began working with John Childs and he is just the best off-spin coach.

"He has taught me so much."

Childs, who played two Tests for England, making his debut at the age of 36, runs the academy at Essex.

These days aged 61, he can, in the words of Jon, "still land them pretty well".

The other Essex academy players to come to Newtown under the Gooch/Insole Program have been Jaik Mickleburgh, Michael Comber and Sam Arthurton.

Jaik is a permanent member of the Essex First XI as an opening batsman. Last season Comber was part of the Essex T20 squad, while Arthurton had an excellent season with the bat for the County's Second XI.

The Gooch/Insole Program is named after England's most prolific batsman, Graham Gooch, and the former head of the MCC, Doug Insole, who was instrumental in setting up the partnership between Newtown and Essex.

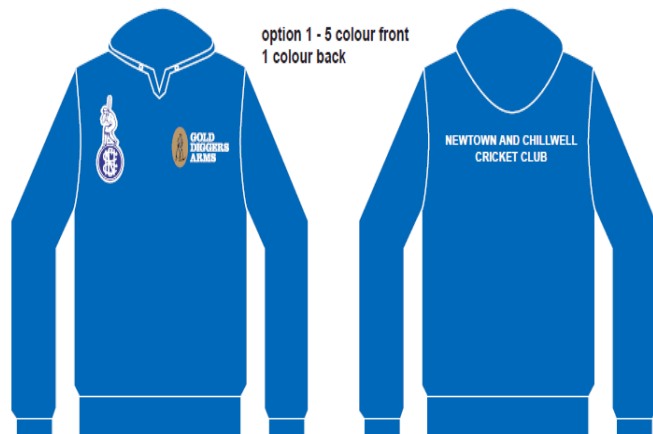

Teenage quick routs the Tigers

A DEVASTATING bowling spell by tall Newtown & Chilwell paceman Jamie Harrison, 19, led the Two Blues to 123-run win over Grovedale at Stinton Oval.

Harrison took career-best figures of 6-29 as the home side dismissed the reigning premier for only 117 and doomed it to its second defeat in as many matches.

To make the loss more significant, it was at the scene of Grovedale's grand final win in March.

Harrison rocked the Tigers' top order, taking

there with opening bowlers from other teams," Ferguson said. "He is definitely fitter and stronger than last year and bowling 5-6km/h faster as well."

At one stage the Newtown & Chilwell bowlers sent down 64 consecutive dot balls, continually building pressure on their Grovedale opponents.

Simon Pearce (56) and Tomas Kearney (22) were able to stop the rot with a stand that took the total from 5-33 to 5-96.

But soon after tea Kearney chipped a drive back to English off-spinner John Carpenter, then Harrison returned to re-

three of the first four wickets as Grovedale crashed to be 4-7 in its pursuit of 240.

"Because the match was reduced to 75 overs we thought we had a total that was above par," Newtown & Chilwell's young captain, Riley Ferguson, said.

"But we thought it was a flat track and we would have to bowl in the right areas and keep the ball on one side of the wicket if we were going to win.

"And it was pleasing that we managed to do that and also, after a few misses against Geelong West, we were able to hold our catches."

Ferguson was also full of praise for fellow teenager, Harrison, who had prepared for his cricket season right through winter.

"His pace is right up

move Pearce. From there the game was never in doubt and Newtown & Chilwell even had time to get in some second innings batting practice.

"Pearce batted well and we knew he was the key wicket," Ferguson said. "At Queens Park the wicket is so flat you can double your score after tea. We had John tying it up from one end with his off-spin and Jamie coming downwind. We knew one more breakthrough and we would be in a good position to go on.

"It was an excellent result for us, but Grovedale are a good side. There's no doubt they will be up there by the end of the season. It's still October, so I thought it would be useful to get some centre wicket practice and that worked out well too."

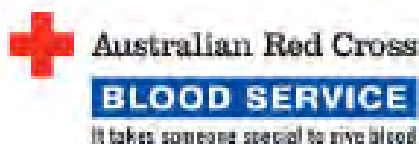
