The Newtown and Chilwell Cricket Club has a major milestone to celebrate in round 11 when we play Geelong City – OUR 1000th First XI match!

Newtown and Chilwell is the only club to have competed in all 85 playing seasons since the Geelong Cricket Association was reformed in 1928/29.

During those years the Club has played a total of 999 games in District Firsts winning 20 First XI premierships from 27 grand final appearances. The great success of the Club can be judged by the fact that the First XI has made the finals in 49 of the 88 seasons.
