FIRST XI defeated East Belmont on Stinton Oval

Place in finals a Two Blue miracle

NEWTOWN & Chilwell, by virtue of a stunning 131-run win over East Belmont, has come from ninth place to grab a spot in the 2013-14 finals.

In a giant-killing performance, the Two Blues did what they had to do and defeated the reigning premiers.

And the three teams above them — Geelong West, Geelong City and Murgheboluc — all lost, which allowed them to jump to sixth.

It's an amazing turnaround for a side that lost five games in a row in the middle of the season.

Protecting 241, Newtown & Chilwell's fast bowlers soon had East Belmont's batsmen struggling.

Cam Alford (3-19), rated by many as the fastest bowler in the competition, led the way with 11 penetrative overs.

East Belmont was already in some difficulty at 3-67 when an Alford spell turned the game irretrievably the way of the home side.

He had Becker Nguyen caught behind by George Chisholm, then removed Jerome Teal and Sean O'Neill for ducks.

With Sam Reidy (3-26) also taking important wickets East Belmont lost 4/10 to slump to the point of no return at 7-77.

Earlier Hamish McDonald (20) had shown some resistance, but with Andrew Baars and Matt Lineker failing and Mark Hanley absent the Lions batting struggled.

Their innings lingered until the 40th over and a total of 110, but when Tim Warburton gave Chisholm his fourth catch off Justin Maher (2-15) it was the end of the line.

JUSTIN Foss's return from injury to the Newtown & Chilwell line-up proved crucial as the Two Blues, making a late charge at the finals, made 241 against East Belmont.

Foss (86*) batted through to the end of the innings from No.5 as the home side fought hard to overcome the accurate Lions attack. Despite a handy contribution from the in-form Riley Ferguson (40), the home side was in trouble at 4-76 and then 8-174.

But Foss kept the innings going in valuable stands with tailenders Nathan Fairchild and Jamie Harrison to add value to the final total.

The East Belmont attack shared the workload and rewards, with Matt Caulfield (3-55) again finishing with the best figures.
