The Second and Thirds both dug deep to make it into the second round of club championship finals this weekend.

Paddy Eastman top-scored for the Seconds in their innings of 175 spread over two days because of the weather. When the final score came through on the App on Sunday, various collections of eminence gris around the club wondered out loud if it was enough.

Just.

Semi-finals specialist Tommy Beaumont got four wickets, Jacko two, before Dimma was the final destroyer.

The Thirds produced another little miracle to beat the number one side, East Belmont.

Toby Sudweeks top-scored with 61 as the Thirds clambered to 191. Again the question was asked ... was it enough?

Well, yes, after Suddsie got a couple of important wickets to back up Scott Sanderson (four wickets) and Tommy Levick (three) with the ball.

Congratulations too, to the Fifths and Sixths, who last Saturday ensured that Newtown and Chilwell would have all six sides qualify for the finals in season 2013/14.

Troy Logan made 109 not out before rain intervened in the game against Murgie.

The draw left the Fifths on top of the ladder.

The Sixth's win over Lara was emphatic, and then some, chasing 194, they lost just one wicket, that of the

skipper, while the two Adams, O'Connor and Patching, both made unbeaten half centuries.

Unfortunately, both the Firsts and the Fourths bowed out on the first weekend of the finals.

The Firsts did well to keep the minor premiers to 228 on a GT/Simmo belter.

Justin Foss rolled back the years with a compelling bowling performance, six wickets, with Cam Alford and Nick Fairchild getting a brace apiece.

In the run chase at a picturesque Stinton Oval, the loss of three early wickets without scoring proved too big a hurdle to overcome, though Jack Wood threatened a couple of times, and George Chisholm batted resolutely.

The Fourths had to chase 327 and fell short. Cam Bishop turned in a fine all-round performance, taking three wickets and top-scoring with 60 out of a noble 199. Lucas Friend shouldered a lot of heavy bowling work, getting through 27 overs.

\Not a bad effort from Blightie behind the stumps, either, three catches, and no byes in that 327.

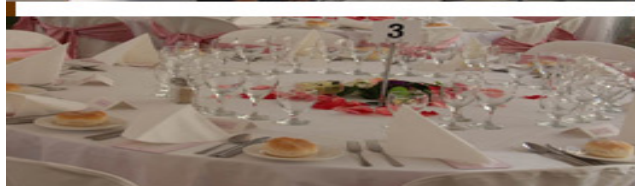

That man Thorne rises to challenge yet again

NORTH Geelong's inspirational and record-breaking captain, Jake Thorne, has taken the Magpies through to the second week of the finals and brought Newtown & Chilwell's late season rally to an end.

Thorne's fifth century of 2013/14 took him to the brink of a magical 1000 runs for the summer and anchored the innings of minor premier North Geelong as it compiled 225 against Newtown & Chilwell.

The Magpies reached 7-176 from 57 overs before the volatile weather stopped play on Saturday.

After winning the toss and batting, they lost Col Millard

immediately to Cam Alford and with Justin Foss fully restored to bowling form were 3-49 before Thorne was joined by the club's former leader, Sam Hall (38).

The pair added a priceless 84 for the fourth wicket to give North Geelong the initiative which it maintained for the rest of the match.

Hall was eventually caught by Dale Denny off the persistent Foss, but Thorne remained unbeaten on 77 when day one concluded.

He went on to his hundred yesterday and then saw Shaun Kingwell establish their ascendancy even further when he claimed three wickets in the

third over of Newtown & Chilwell's reply. Justin Foss led the way for the Two Blues with a brilliant 6/70.

The Two Blues continued to fight a losing cause until they were bowled out for 110.

Thorne continued his man-of-the-match performance by taking four wickets to add to his century. Jack Wood (31) and Jon Simson provided some resistance but it was a strong before by the Magpies to advance to next weekend's semi finals.
