My decision was made on a very wet Tuesday night when we had moved inside to have a drink, I looked outside the front door of the club rooms to see his father hitting him catches in the pouring rain. From that moment his season had turned, he started moving well, some of the catches that he took were amazing and his season peaked with a legside stumping off Ian Hastie in a victorious grand final.....  
This year's Captain's award for the Seconds goes to **Chris Hadfield**.
- Third XI** This is always a very difficult award to give and this season was no exception. Throughout season 2005/2006 I have, as captain, had great support from all players and can comfortably say that every single player that represented the Third XI stood proud for the club and also themselves.  
  
As such it made this difficult decision all the more arduous. However it still must be awarded and one individual has performed outstandingly this year and it is on that criteria have awarded my captain's award to **Adam Lavars**.  
  
Adam's season is truly outstanding, 710 runs at an average of 50.71, 3 centuries with a high score of 123. Although not thrown the ball often early in the season when time came for Adam to bowl again he performed excellently 18 wickets at 17.39. His fielding was also outstanding collecting 9 catches (and a stumping) and stopping immeasurable runs with athletic dives and aggression to the ball. His support to not only myself, his team mates and the team's objectives were also unquestionable.  
  
I congratulate Adam on receiving my captain's award and hope that in season 2006/2007 he makes a commitment to the club, but also to himself to realize the full potential of his abilities in the turf grades.

Long, long before Mark Latham thought it was an original idea, David Barnes decided that the best way to serve his community was to do so within a sporting club.

At this point, standing at the bar and going the colour of the letters on the scoreboard in embarrassment, Barnso did acknowledge the suggestion the year book might just finish second to one, as in Wisden, though we all agreed hastily, only just. And if the year book is part of the compulsory reading in your dunny, well check your membership, you're probably a closet Lawn-mower.

At that other celebrated club up the road – Geelong Football Club - they're frightened to name things after people while they're still alive for fear of them going off the rails. That is something we need have no fear of. Indeed Barnso still has much good to do on behalf of cricket in Geelong. We look

forward to that because it will mean the strength and sense of history he has brought to our club will take root in a broader field. At the moment though, those who've known Barnso all those 24 summers and more, and those who've come along later in his vocation, acknowledge gleefully that we play for a club made unique by the contributions of many people, one of the more singular and significant of whom is David Paul Barnes.
