Under 15 Tom Jefferies was a member of the regional Rocket's team and also played up to 3<sup>rd</sup> eleven. Mitch Davis and Toby Sudweeks were core members of the 6<sup>th</sup> grade as 14 year olds, both worthy candidates for senior awards.
