



The wrap up of season 2006/07



Annus Horribilis - season 607

Is one way to describe the incredibly frustrating season 2006/07 recently completed early for Geelong Cricket Association senior cricketers. Without doubt, debate will continue for a long time over the ways and means the most drought affected season in the GCA's 110 seasons was handled but in the end what matters is that it was all over in January.

More importantly from a Club perspective, not only was the season short in longevity but certainly in result. Two senior finals teams resulted in only the Sixths participating in the rain affected grand final. 90 players were required to fill the six senior teams and clearly too many casual players not willing to commit to the cause held the club back. The shortened season

saw a win/loss across the board percentage of 49/49 from 57 matches, the worst in over 40 years.

An average Club Championship position of eighth combined with a thoroughly unpalatable 13th of 14 team placement by the First XI despite the hard luck stories and just misses along the way. Clearly not good enough for the Newtown and Chilwell Cricket Club.

However, all is not lost as there were many positives to come from the year. If we are smart and develop, encourage and foster a string of talented youngsters we can roll into season 2007/08 with new rooms, strong administration and plenty of opportunity for anyone willing to take their chances.

Father-son rule pays dividends

THERE will be no shortage of family support when Newtown and Chilwell takes to the field in this Saturday's Sixth XI Grand Final.

A total of five father-son combinations will play a part in the big game against East Belmont.

Captain Mark Turnley has son Dean in the team, while there is also Paul and Jai Sheahan, Andrew and Campbell Bishop, Jason and Sam Connelly and wicketkeeper Darcy Del Rio, whose father Mig is the team's scorer.

The other members of the team are Ben Hunt, brother of Geelong footballer Josh, and Julian Groves.

Turnley senior said the line-

up was put together to encourage juniors to stay at the club.

"We had a lot of problems with junior retention, boys started drifting away when they were 16-17 so we thought if we could give them a good time and a pleasant experience playing with their fathers they might stay with the club," he said.

"The club's been really supportive, it has become a policy that the sixths become a pathway team.

"It was a conscious decision to go that way — to have the fun factor for fathers and sons and to provide a pathway for juniors into senior cricket."

Turnley said not only was the idea keeping kids involved in

the club, it was also giving families memories they would remember for a long time.

"We hope so, probably for the fathers more so," he said.

"It's fairly significant in their twilight years to play a few more years with their son.

"I'm 49 so I'm getting close (to retiring). Paul Sheahan is 40, Andrew Bishop is 42 and Jason Connelly is 39 so we're all getting on a bit."

Turnley said his side would take underdog status into this week's Grand Final.

"If we play well we're a chance, but it'll just be a great experience for fathers and sons just to play in a Grand Final together," he said.
