Two Blues outclassed in semis

Semi finals weekend saw the season draw to an abrupt end as the Thirds, Fourths and Fifths were all outclassed.

A commanding opening partnership of 134 by East Belmont Thirds bats set the home team up for a total of 287 at Winter Reserve. Brett Bentley's side was completely out gunned collapsing for 112. Yves Roussety (31) and Jamie Pescott (27) providing the only real resistance.

It was a similar situation at Belmont Common where Grant Whiteside's Fourth XI was out played. The Fourth XI staged a great comeback against East Belmont at South Barwon 3 on Saturday reducing the Lions to 172. With 20 overs left the Lions were 3/137 but the break through came from Paul Smith (5/42) and Chris Hocking (4/50). Shooter's 27 over effort was an outstanding performance. The batting on the Sunday saw only Matt Suvoltos (30) and Chris Hocking (23) contributing to a disappointing total of 96.

The Fifth XI started badly against top side, Corio Bay, and it never got much better as the afternoon progressed.

Paul Sheahan (24) and Neville Crane (34 not out) were the only shining lights of the team's 100 run inning.

In reply Corio (get your own afternoon tea) Bay was 1/47 at stumps and went on to lose a further three wickets completing the chase on Sunday.

So, for the first time since 1996/97 the club has no senior grand finalist and no premiership to celebrate for the first time in seven seasons.

On the weekend East Belmont showed us the way with their first four teams advancing to grand finals. Hard edged, skilful teams determined to perform for their club. No club has won all four flags but East Belmont teams did all finish on top.

Over the winter we have a lot of thinking, planning and soul searching to do to come up with a united plan for the coming seasons.
