Four teams fight for grand final spots

But the prior to that, some sensational individual efforts showed the way for great team performances to see four Two Blue teams into the semis.

Paul Dowling with 4/41 and two super caught and bowleds did best with the ball.

Speaking of leadership, none better on the weekend than Steve Lewis and his super 122 in the Fourths which ensured a hefty 263 was posted at Belmont Common. The heat took its toll on the top of the ladder superweights but Brett Bentley, Jase Clark, two LBWs from Casa and some superb keeping by Grant Whiteside (4 stumpings) saw the Fours through.

Mark Turnley's Sixths joined the finals fun with a last round win over Bell Post Hill but unfortunately the Fifths last round win was not enough to see it into the top four.

Yes, now for the real finals after the weekend's warm ups in some more reasonable weather.

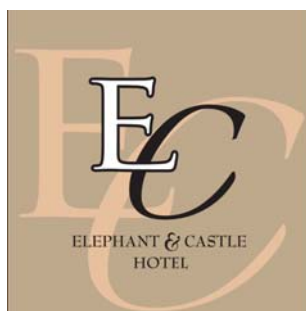


