Morning All,

We had our August committee meeting last week and I'd thought I'd bring you up to date with some of the developments.

A major issue for us this year is finance. There is some uncertainty now about the starting time of the major refurbishment of the complex at Queens Park. The earliest construction is likely to start in now October 9. My feeling is that it will be later than that.

This makes our bar operations this year uncertain, which flows on to our overall financial situation.

With this in mind, we have done a number of things.

One, we are going to have mobile Elfpos facilities at the club. The committee looked at three options last week and we've decided to go with our current banker, Westpac.

The big issue, as it always is, is subs. We had a long discussion about our approach to non-financial players last night. Generally over the past couple of seasons things have improved enormously, with fewer and fewer players failing to pay.

But we can still get better. At the end of last night's discussions a motion was put that subs would be due, as they are normally, by October 31. Anyone who was not financial by November 30, a full four weeks grace, would be not affiliated with the GCA, not covered by insurance and thus ineligible to play for Newtown and Chilliwell Cricket Club.

As I said, most players do pay not only on time, but early. In this financial year we need that to be every player.

Our membership manager, Matt Suvoltos, has the full support of the committee in his role of ensuring that 100 per cent record.

As we have pointed out before, the subs for a senior player are \$250 but it costs the club approx \$350 to put each senior player on the paddock. We would like to be able to channel all our energies into raising that extra \$100 per player, not chasing up players for the first \$250.

Congratulations to Phil Morgan, who has become the first player in season 2006/2007 to make a subs payment!

Just re-confirming the fees.

Senior - \$250.

Senior concession - \$150.

Junior - \$75.

Junior Family - \$130.

Social - \$30

With the establishment of the Elfpos service, paying has never been easier.

On other issues, we put nine recommendations to the GCA re improvements to the way the game is run and played in Geelong. Not one of these was adopted. I am now on the GCA Management Committee so hopefully we can improve the input we have into the governing body.

We are still on the lookout for a couple of scorers for the First and the Seconds. If you know anyone who would be interested, let me or the Secretary know.

It's early days yet, but the signs are good we will have a great summer ahead of us.

The committee is working enthusiastically at both the senior and junior level. Mark Turnley is holding junior registration day on August 27 at 10am and we would love to see as many senior players there as possible to help out.

Barry is working hard towards the start of pre-season and he's still trying to recruit a couple more players.

You play as you train so let's train the house down for the next two months.
