Geelong's suffered its first loss in the Victoria Over 60s Cricket Association competition last Sunday, going down to the powerful Bayside by three wickets.

However, there was one local winner on the day – Stinton Oval at Queens Park.

Bayside captain David Haynes said Stinton Oval was easily the best ground in the competition and other VOSCA officials believe it to be the perfect venue to host future international games between England and Australia.

On Sunday, Geelong scored 159 from its 40 overs with opener John Mann and man of the match Ian "IP" McGregor both making stylish 40s.

Graeme Taylor, who smote on mighty six, Ian Foote, Don Everett and Daryl Tucker – at 69 the team's oldest player - also made handy contributions.

A long, long time ago, Daryl was introduced to under 15s cricket by David Shaw. The two men met up again on Sunday for the first time since those days.

Back to the game itself, Taylor and McGregor also took important wickets, but in the end, Bayside's Australian representative Ian Longmuir and Corio-based all-rounder Norm Eccles took the game away from Geelong with the bat.

"Our batsmen did well but the bowlers have immediately been ordered to the nets," said Geelong captain Bernie Clancy, who also happens to be one of the bowlers.

"Essentially though, Bayside were too good for us on the day but we look forward to the return clash in a few weeks."

"IP" McGregor was named man of the match for his classy batting and handy two wickets. His prize includes a massage with SportMedicine Massage's Bengt Carlson.

"I wish I could arrange it for right now," McGregor said with a mixture of a wince and a smile.

Sharks bite in battle for spoon

IN what might have easily been an early battle for the wooden spoon, Manifold Heights had a confidence boosting win over Newtown & Chilwell at Hurst Reserve on Saturday.

All-rounder Ben Knight was the hero for the Sharks, making a valuable 35 not out and then taking a superb 6-11 to ruin an initially promising Two Blues batting performance.

Newtown & Chilwell captain Ben Neville lamented what he saw as an opportunity missed.

"It was a huge game for us and Manifold Heights, too, of course," Neville said.

"I felt we controlled most of the match, so it was disappointing that our batting became undisciplined and we showed a lack of experience in knowing how to win.

"And credit to them. They took their chances better than us and in the end deserved their victory."

New captain Craig Booley won the toss, took first use of the wicket and must have been reasonably satisfied when his side reached 8-185, especially after being 3-39 early on.

"We had aimed to get three wickets in the first 10 overs and achieved that," Neville said.

"But from there our intensity dropped and a couple of straightforward catches went down, which allowed them to get back into the game."

Luke Turner (36), who made his top score of the season, held the top order together and with his former captain Adrian McCormack added an important 31 for the fourth wicket that brought the match on to an even keel.

Then when Knight was joined by Booley, the Manifold Heights batting depth began to tell.

"The deck was a bit up and down," Neville said.

"And being the home side, they knew how to bat best on it."

Neville (25), Tim Clark (33) and Nick Richardson (45) also showed they could handle the track and at 2-125 with plenty of overs up their sleeve the Two Blues were in the box seat.

Knight then took control. Bowling straight and with good pace, he instigated a collapse that saw eight wickets fall for 36. Four of his victims were adjudged LBW and four Two Blues batsmen failed to score.

Pushing singles with the field back, Damian O'Loughlin and Anthony Wilson enabled the visitors to sneak up to 161 before last man, Tom Beaumont, was dismissed in the 45th over.

"The damage had really already been done by then," Neville said.

"Losing so many wickets in the middle order killed us. Last on the ladder is not a place Newtown & Chilwell has often been. We have another huge game against Leopold next week and that is a must win."
