Dear James,

On behalf of the board, staff and volunteers from Lifeline Geelong and Barwon Region, I sincerely thank the Newtown and Chilwell Cricket Club and all those involved in organising and running the 20-20 Cricket Day "Hitting Depression for a Six".

It was a very enjoyable day for participants and spectators alike and I am sure offered great support for Jason Clark's family, friends and cricket colleagues. The Lifeline Geelong tent received several inquiries during the day for information on depression and post suicide support, proving there is a need in our community for our counselling services.

The funds raised from the event will make a difference in our community support work and will go towards two of our professional staff attending an intensive training course in Adelaide for the 'LivingWorks' ASSIST suicide first aid workshop course and the Safe TALK suicide awareness program. On their return they will be qualified to run community workshops and training seminars for the prevention of suicide.

In light of a spate of youth suicides last year in our region there is an urgent need to train more interested groups within our community to give them the skills to recognise the signs of people at risk with severe depression and how best to engage them to assist in the prevention of suicide.

'LivingWorks' is a Lifeline Australia national service. This service has a network of 450 trainers, from over forty organisations, to bring its internationally respected training to local communities near you. Their mission statement best describes why we are training our staff to run these workshops in our community.

Our mission is to create learning experiences that help communities prevent suicide.

We aim to provide sustainable, life-assisting resources in the community so that the benefits of our programs live on.

We seek to promote suicide aware communities where people are more alert to suicide intervention opportunities.

I look forward to attending your President's Dinner on February 27th and please pass on my thanks to your committee and colleagues for their support, it is very much appreciated.
